It's Showtime!

Everyone is encouraged to bring plants to the show.

Plants may be dropped off at the SCBG Friday afternoon, **September 20th**, from 4 PM to 8 PM. Plants will be ready to be picked-up at the conclusion of the show, **Sunday Sept. 22nd** <u>after</u> 4 PM.

A few guidelines to remember:

- All plants must be identified (labeled) to be judged. Unidentified plants will be used for "exhibit only" and will not be judged.
- >No decorative pots or arrangements.
- Make sure plants are clean and free of insects. A solution of 50% milk and water may be used to wipe and shine the leaves.

Two forms must be completed for each plant: a registration form for the entry book and an identification card for the plant. Entry forms are available from the SBOS website at this link. http://www.southbayorchidsociety.com/Show/index.html

The forms will also be available at the check-in desk.

Determining Your Orchid Lighting

I found the following internet page and thought that maybe the membership might find it interesting. I would suspect that most of us do not have light meters for measuring how many foot candles of light our plants are getting. This past weekend, I heard a lot of growers and sellers saying, "Put it in a East window, or a nice bright window". I was doing some searching to figure out just how much light my plants were getting. A lot of books and dealers will say, "This plant needs about 2000fc etc." I know there are books around, but sometimes we just don't find them when we want them. Most of us have cameras that will give us a reading that can be converted to foot candles. Here is a page that does it for you.

To make it simple:

Set your ASA to 50 and take a light reading.

f16 = 4000 fc, f22 = 8000, f32 = 16000

Set your ASA to 100

f16 = 200, f22 = 4000, f32 = 8000

Set your ASA to 200

f8 = 250, f11 = 500, f16 = 1000, f22 = 2000, f32 = 4000, f64 = 8000

Membership Reminder

Annual Fall Orchid Show and Sale September 21 & 22, 2013 South Coast Botanic Garden

Our fall show is coming soon and planning is well underway. Vendors have signed up and publicity is getting out, but your participation is needed to make this show a success.

Set-up: Takes place on Friday morning before the show at 10:00. This involves setting up and arranging tables as well as draping of the display tables. We will also need help loading our "show stuff" into trucks from storage unit. Call Larry Bergen at (310)326-5405 or Ron Henry at (310) 374-9699.

Host and Hostess: People are needed throughout the show hours to talk to our guests and answer questions they may have. This position is also important for security. You need to make sure no one touches the plants or walks off with one. (Plant theft is a serious problem at some shows.) This position also includes the "plant hotel" table where people can check purchased plants, since they are not allowed in the judging area, and the "welcome table" to hand out raffle tickets. If you would like to help on Saturday call Kayo Libiano at 310-897-8085 or if you prefer to help on Sunday call Charlie Brown at (310)377-7083.

Food: Lots of food is needed to feed our hungry volunteers and vendors throughout the show. If you are bringing food on Sunday, it needs to be there by 11:30 am. Call June Brooks (310) 549-4266 or Joann Green (310) 830-1585 to let them know what dish you will be bringing so they can be sure there is enough food.

Take-down: Will take place right after the show closes at 4:00 on Sunday. We need everyone to pitch in and help to make this job go quickly. Again, Ron and Larry will need help putting our "show stuff" back into storage on Monday. Call Ron Henry at (310) 374-9699.

Plant Registration: Registration will take place on Friday in the auditorium beginning at 4:00 pm and ending at 8:00 pm. I hope everyone will bring in all their blooming plants for judging. I have noticed that some of the best plants have been in the novice category so don't be shy about putting your plants in the show for ribbon judging. All we ask is they have been in your possession for a minimum of 3 months and be free of pests and disease. The registration classifications and forms are available on the website if you want to get a head start on the registration process. If you are not sure how to classify your plants, we will have people to help you.

Volunteering a few hours of your time is a great way to get to know your fellow society members and we always have a good time. Feel free to phone me if you have any questions regarding the show.

Besides needing people to bring food, we also need boxes and old newspapers for the plant hotel. If you have extra boxes at home or if you are in a store where they are stocking shelves, please bring them to the show with you.

Get Your Plants Ready !

Start working with your plants now to get them ready before the September Show.

- Check them for insect infestations. Treat as needed.
- Remove dead brown leaves. Trim off brown leaf ends using a clean razor blade for each plant.
- Stake up flower spikes.
- Add fresh bark to the top of the pot if your level has gone down.
- Clean /polish leaves using a solution of 50% milk and 50% water.
