# Annual Spring Orchid Show and Sale February 21 & 22, 2015 Torrance Cultural Arts Center

Our spring show is coming soon and planning is well underway. Vendors have signed up and publicity is getting out, but your participation is needed to make this show a success. We have members who have volunteered to be committee chairs and they need you to sign up to help.

**Set-up:** Takes place on Friday morning before the show at 10:00. This involves setting up and arranging tables as well as draping of the display tables. We will also need help loading our "show stuff" into trucks from storage unit. Call Larry Bergen at (310) 326-5405 or Ron Henry at (310) 374-9699.

Host and Hostess: People are needed throughout the show hours to talk to our guests and answer questions they may have. This position is also important for security. You need to makes sure no one touches the plants or walks off with one. (Plant theft is a serious problem at some shows.) This position also includes the "plant hotel" table where people can check purchased plants, since they are not allowed in the judging area, and the "welcome table" to hand out raffle tickets. If you would like to help on Saturday call Larry Bergen at (310) 326-5405 or if you prefer to help on Sunday call Charlie Brown at (310) 377-7083.

**Food:** Lots of food is needed to feed our hungry volunteers and vendors throughout the show. If you are bringing food on Sunday, it needs to be there by 11:30 am. Call June Brooks (310) 549-4266 or Joann Green (310) 830-1585 to let them know what dish you will be bringing so they can be sure there is enough food.

**Take-down:** Will take place right after the show closes at 5:00 on Sunday. We need everyone to pitch in and help to make this job go quickly. Again, Ron and Larry will need help putting our "show stuff" back into storage on Monday. Call Ron Henry at (310) 374-9699.

**Plant Registration:** Registration will take place on Friday in the auditorium beginning at 4:00 pm and ending at 8:00 pm. I hope everyone will bring in all their blooming plants for judging. I have noticed that some of the best plants have been in the novice category so don't be shy about putting your plants in the show for ribbon judging. All we ask is they have been in your possession for a minimum of 3 months and be free of pests and disease. The registration classifications and forms are available on the website if you want to get a head start on the registration process. If you are not sure how to classify your plants, we will have people to help you.

Volunteering a few hours of your time is a great way to get to know your fellow society members and we always have a good time. Feel free to phone me if you have any questions regarding the show.

Besides needing people to bring food, we also need boxes for the plant hotel. If you have extra boxes at home or if you are in a store where they are stocking shelves, please bring them to the show with you.




