The Kovachii are Coming! The Kovachii are Coming!

When Phragmepedium kovachii was discovered it made quite a stir, not only because of it's size and beauty, but also because of the greed and subterfuge involved. People were being charged with criminal activity for collecting and importing plants. Lots of noise was made about it in any case. After a number of years, the plants became available to the general public, but at horrendous prices. Piping Rock Orchids (Glen Decker), Orchids Limited (Jason Fisher), and Mount Prospects Orchids had them but the price was in four figures and not necessarily starting with a one. It was literally a question of how many thousands of dollars a person had to spend to get one.

The next break came when a number of very nice Phrag. kovachii hybrids became available for reasonable prices. I started acquiring these whenever I could find them, but always lusted after the real thing. Recently I decided to eat dog food for a month and spend some real money. I banged my head against a wall and came up with nothing available short of \$1,500 to \$3,000 if the plant was in bud. Then I saw a well-established seedling offered on eBay for \$400. I missed that one, but started digging around and found two plants from 'Lucky Girl Orchids', which I bought. A smaller plant with two growths cost me \$100 and a larger one with four growths went for \$250. These are straight Phrag. kovachii, not hybrids.

It is still a far cry from the \$7.50 table at Santa Barbara Orchid Estates, but I consider it a breakthrough. It was not cheap, but doable. I guess as time goes by they will become even cheaper, but it is now reasonable to start looking around for them. Lucky Girl Orchids does not have any more right now. I took both of the ones she had, but I'm sure she'll take reservations and try to find you one. Attached are the photos of the two I purchased.

Wish me luck in growing them.
