This month's guest speaker is Phyllis S. Prestia. Phyllis will give us a presentation on the native terrestrial orchids of Europe. Her latest passion centers on her travels and photographs of conservation efforts in France and French orchid societies. Phyllis has also traveled extensively through the rainforests of Madagascar and the Galapagos Islands.

Phyllis is a retired educator and middle school principal. She received a Doctorate of Education at Rutgers University, where she also served as instructor in the graduate education program.

Originally from New Jersey, she moved to California to retire in the sunny San Diego area and grow orchids. Her collection includes a variety of species and hybrids across several genera grown both in a small greenhouse as well as three outdoor growing areas under shade cloth.

In her orchid life Phyllis has been the president of the San Diego County Cymbidium Society and

she currently serves as the vice-president of the Cymbidium Society of America (CSA). She served as second vice-president for Palomar Orchid Society, as well as chairman of the annual auction committee for several years. She is active in and a member of several Southern California orchid societies and is accredited Judge of the CSA and an Associate Judge for the American Orchid Society (AOS). Phyllis is a current member of the Editorial Board of the Orchid Digest and serves as an AOS Trustee.
