Our May 19, 2023 guest speaker will be Jose Carlos Lopez "The Four Seasons of Cattlevas"

Jose Carlos Lopez is a Business student at Mira Costa College who has been cultivating orchids for over seven years. His orchid venture began at the age of thirteen years old when he started to follow his father to work at Sunset Valley Orchids. Before he knew it, he was volunteering at the nursery and was helping clean orchid flasks, re-pot orchids, and doing small tasks. Carlos eventually began become more involved in the greenhouse operations/maintenance and started to take part in attending orchid shows. He is currently Sunset Valley Orchids Manager and has years of experience with Cattleya, Catasetum, Australian Dendrobiums, and Sarcochilus. Jose Carlos Lopez is currently training to become an American Orchid Society Judge and works with Orchid Digest as well.

The Four Seasons of Cattleyas presentation will include information on caring for Cattleyas throughout the year & will include cultural cues for species and hybrids that root at different times. We will explore the species that bloom in each season, discussing their different varieties and important cultural requirements. From the large flowered unifoliate species to the fragrant and colossal bifoliate Cattleyas, this talk will also showcase a few hybrids too.

I found the crosses fascinating also the fact that there are numerous crosses which have not been named or recorded. The variation of color and flower shape were phenomenal. I hope that he was correct that these plants are easy to grow and produce numerous sprays of flowers. Maybe next fall show we will have some examples in bloom. Now is the time to begin with your cymbidium care. You can remove the remnants of last year's leaves. Next you can determine if your plant needs to be repotted, or upsized to a larger pot. I like to add time release fertilizer to the top of my mix. Also, it is time to change the fertilizer from bloom 10-30-30 to grow 30-10-10. I also like to begin spraying for bugs. I use ferti.lome triple action. I will spray all of my collection every other week for six weeks. Finally, I would like to thank all the members for bringing in plants to share. The variety, color, and quality were tremendous. I look forward to seeing all of the members at our next meeting and hearing Carlos Lopez tell us about 'The Four Seasons of Cattleyas'. I have quite a few cattleyas in my collection. Remember if you know someone who is interested in orchids, invite them to come to one of our meetings. I hope to see you at the May meeting.
